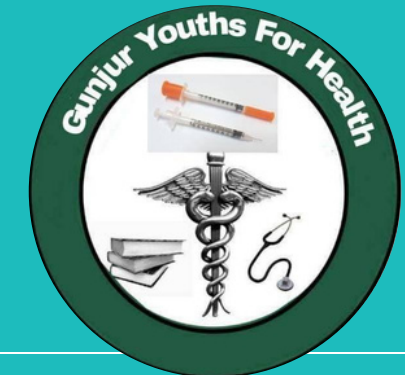

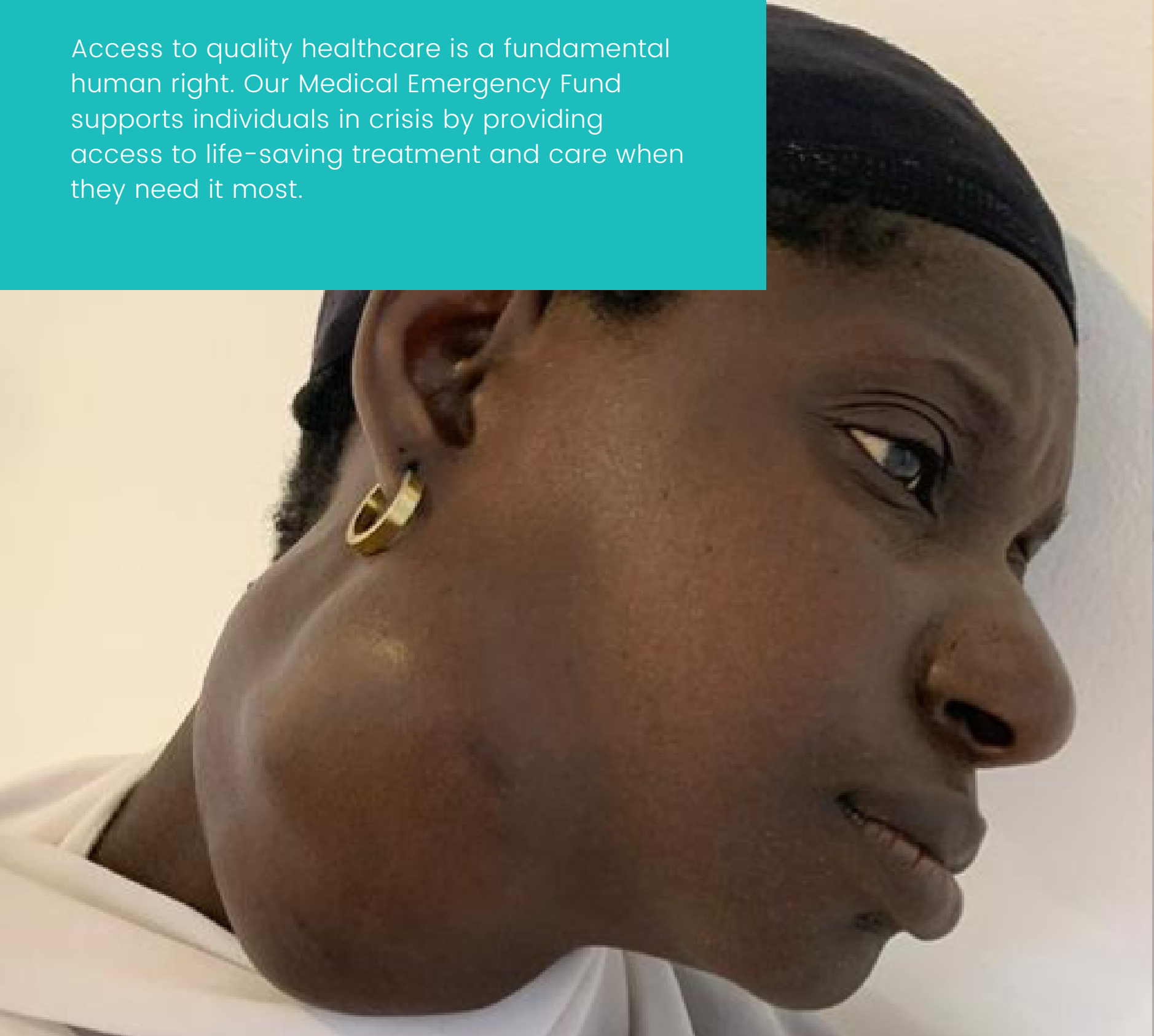
Eye Project

Our Eye Project partners with the Sheikh Zayed Eye Clinic to provide treatment for individuals suffering from eye conditions such as cataracts, glaucoma and other eye-related illnesses.

We have funded many cataract operations and are currently supplying monthly eye drops for Glaucoma patients to try and reduce the risk of blindness.

Access to quality healthcare is a fundamental human right. Our Medical Emergency Fund supports individuals in crisis by providing access to life-saving treatment and care when they need it most.

Weekend Study Classes

We provide weekend classes for a group of 30 students aged between 9 and 16 years old. Led by qualified Gambian teachers and supported by a wellbeing coach, these sessions help students improve their skills in maths and English while also focusing on their emotional, physical, and mental well-being through dedicated well-being classes.



Women Empowerment



Our Women Empowerment Programs are designed to empower and uplift women, helping them become the best versions of themselves by learning new skills and managing their lives more effectively. We offer a range of programs, including catering, literacy, arts, and crafts, along with a dedicated wellbeing program that supports both physical and mental health. Additionally, when we have medically trained visitors, we take the opportunity to provide open advice sessions, allowing women to ask questions and receive guidance on their health.

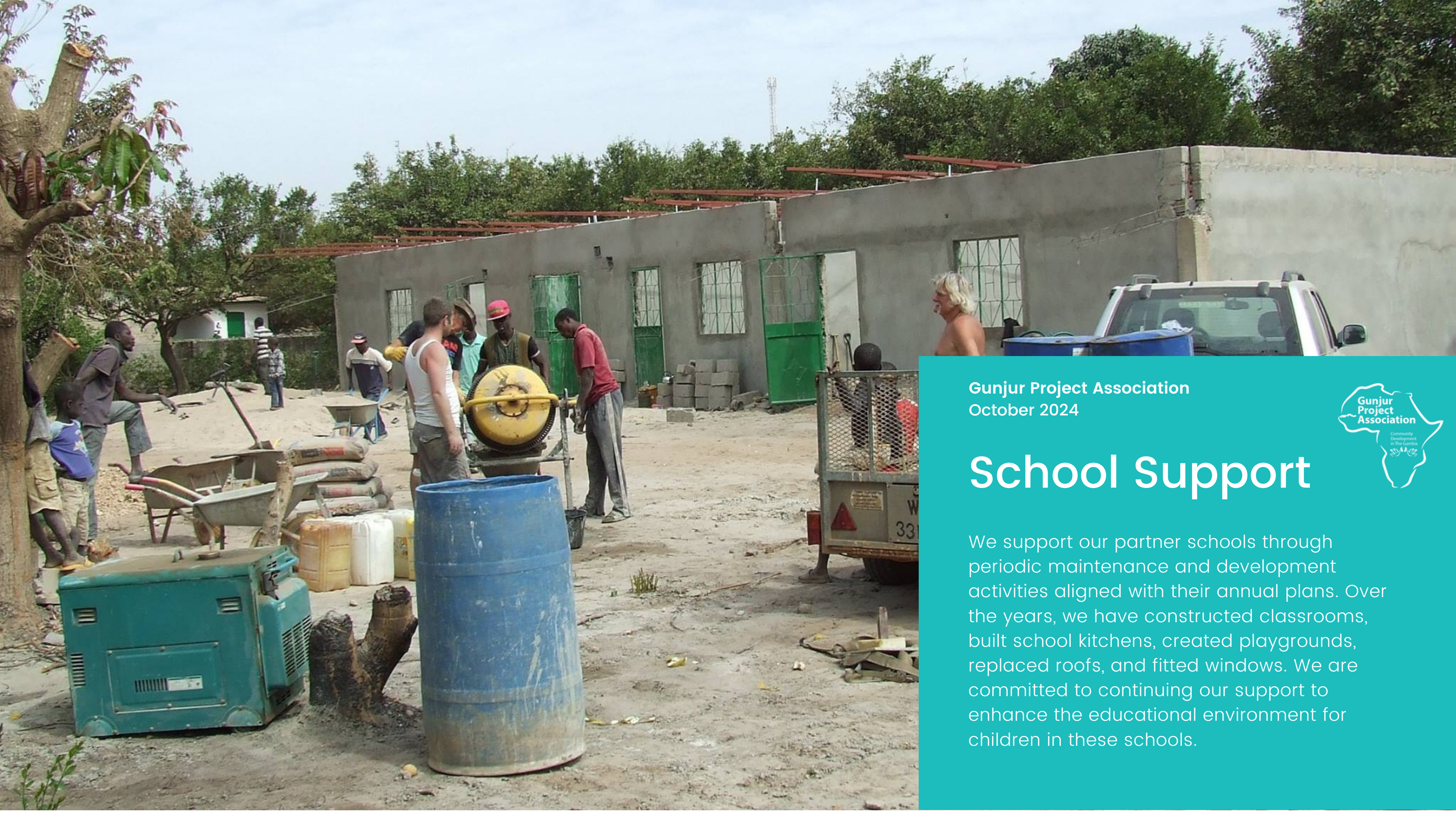
